

# Dundee Community Wellbeing Centre

**Dundee Health and Social Care Partnership Board** started plans in April 2021 to develop a Community Wellbeing Centre (CWC) to **improve Mental Health Crisis and Urgent Care services** in Dundee.

The Centre will give quick and caring help, **24 hours a day 7 days a week**, to anyone in distress and provide more than signposting. It will give support to those **needing access to a range of third sector & statutory services**.

The Centre will run with **people's needs being most important**. It will connect individuals with lots of different services and support.

The Centre will be in the **Hillcrest building on South Ward Road**, Dundee, behind the Overgate. Work has started on the centre to transform it for the estimated opening within the later part of 2022.

The Community Wellbeing Centre will be run by a charitable organisation. Choosing the organisation is in progress. All plans for the centre have been designed by **members of the public and service staff** who joined a planning group run by **Dundee Volunteer & Voluntary Action (DVVA)**.
